*Parent Volunteer List*

## **Cafe**

### - Cooks

\*Volunteers who would like to run the kitchen during youth group, cook up food for the students, and provide fun new additions to the Cafe Menu.

### - Shoppers

\*Volunteers who would like to bless the Cafe by giving time to go to the super market and purchase refreshments and stock up the Cafe; either in the LHCYouth budget or donations.

### - Overseers

\*Volunteers who feel they are organized and would like to run the Cafe's operations: organizing and executing events involving the Cafe (for both the Youth Ministry, and whole Church events), keeping an up-to-date record of resources and food, and assisting in clean up and tear down of events.

### - Worker

\*Volunteers who work behind the counter of the Cafe itself, to collect the money for the refreshments from the students, hand the refreshments to the students, and be a welcoming and positive face to the Cafe.

## **Game Workers.**

\*Volunteers who would like to run around with students and either join in the game of the evening, start a conversation with students who don't wish to play, or start another game with a small group of students that didn't want to play the large game.

## **Security**

### - Check in station

\*Volunteers who run check in would simply be signing students into the same check in station as is used for children's ministry, and making sure new comers are given the welcome form, for information and follow up. Point of this job is to prevent students from leaving without cause, and keeping a record of how often each student visits youth group (for follow up purposes).

### - Patrolmen

\*Volunteers who serve here would walk the grounds periodically to keep students from wondering off (such as walking to Dunkin Donuts), as well as keeping the parking lot and surrounding area safe from dangerous drivers or unknown visitors.

**Leaders.**

-Small Group

\*Volunteers who lead a small group would be involved in a small group of students on a weekly basis; to meet with the small group, talk with them on topics at large in their lives, listen to them, and facilitate deeper walk with Jesus.

-Table Leaders

\*Volunteers who are table leaders would simply sit with students during sunday night sessions at youth group, keeping them focused on the topic at hand, pour into them in casual conversation, and simply be a voice of encouragement in a very unofficial manner.

- Dinner Donating

\*Volunteers who are willing to cook a meal for the leaders who sacrifice their evening to be with students - and either order dinner during open gym, or miss out entirely. Volunteers could either donate an already assembled meal to be reheated, or prepare a fresh meal in the kitchen (in the gym.)
